Within Solent Child and Family Services, we offer healthy weight pathways within our 0-19 services for children aged under 5. Within community paediatric medical services, we follow the guidance on the PIER website about investigations and thresholds for referral. These may yield referrals to University Hospitals Southampton (both secondary and tertiary services) or to Portsmouth Hospitals University Trust for a secondary care service known as the CEW clinic depending upon the location that the child resides.
